Activities:

1. Paper Plate Masks
2. Flour Playdough Garden

Paper Plate Masks

Approx. Time: 30 minutes

Supplies:

- Paper Plate
- Scissors
- Straw/popsicle stick (up for interpretation)
- Craft Paper
- Decorations

Activity Instructions:

1. Cut your paper plate in half (optional)
2. Cut two holes out for the eyes
3. Glue your stick to your mask
 - a. Half Plate - To the side on the flat edge
 - b. Full Plate - On the bottom
4. Customize!!



Magic Garden - Flour Playdough Garden of your Choice!

Approx. Time: 45 min

Supplies:

- 2 cups of plain flour
- 1 cup salt
- 1 tablespoons of oil
- 1 cup cold water
- Food colouring (edible) or Markers (ink - not edible)
- Toothpick / Bobby pin
- Mixing bowl
- Spoon/mixing tool

Activity Instructions:

Flour Playdough:

1. Combine flour and salt, mix.
2. Add water and oil. Food colouring is optional.
3. Knead well.
4. If the consistency is too wet, add flour as desired.



Mushroom:

1. Roll a small piece of clay into a ball and then flatten it.
2. Wrap the piece of clay around the end of a marker, giving it a dome-like shape.
3. Use the other piece of clay and roll it into a snake, making one side narrower.
4. Attach the narrow side to the bottom of the dome shaped clay piece.
5. Use the excess clay to add polka dots on the top of the mushroom.

Flower

1. Get a piece of clay and divide it into 5 small pieces.
2. Roll each piece into a small ball, pinch one of the ends, and flatten it to get a petal shape.
3. Bring all the pointy ends together and connect them.
4. Use another piece of clay, roll it into a ball and place it in the centre.
5. Use a toothpick or bobby pin to add texture to the flower. Decorate with markers once dry.



Make sure to let flour playdough dry for at least 24 hours!
